

# Policing in Hale End and Highams Park



As you may know, two Police Stations in Forest Rd, Walthamstow and Francis Rd., Leyton closed some time ago as a result of the policies of the Conservative London Mayor. These buildings were sold by the GLA (Greater London Authority) for property development and plans for 20 flats have been received by the council. This loss has led to under policing across London including our

ward and the remaining police station for our area is on King's Head Hill, Chingford.

Owing to cuts imposed by the London Mayor's office we have a reduced force of PCSOs (Police Community Support Officers) in the borough down from 100 to 48. Consequently, our own conscientious and hardworking Safer Neighbourhood Team now renamed the Local Policing Team (LPT), now covers our ward and Hatch Lane. To our knowledge our Council has not fought this change. Our LPT has 1 sergeant to direct 2 wards, 1 Police Constable and 1 PCSO for each ward. There are 2 other PCSOs to help where needed.

Your Focus Team says this is inadequate local policing.



The Evening Standard reported on the 31st March that our constituency, Chingford and Woodford Green, has the second highest number of low paid jobs in the country. Shockingly, 43% of local jobs are paid less than the living wage which is £8.80 per hour.

From April local workers will be paying £700-a- year less in Income Tax thanks to the **Lib Dems**. However the local Lib Dems want to go even further by increasing the Income Tax cut up to £800 a year.

Thorpe Hall School reports that in the academic year 2012/13 the school received £148.000, for its


pupils and in the academic year 2014/15 it will rise to £200.000, making the sum per pupil rise from £900-£1300.

**Council Continues to Waste Your Money** 

Recent Freedom of Information figures have highlighted that Waltham Forest Labour-run Council spent a massive £279,000 on the Olympic Torch relay, while Wandsworth spent only

£710.14. This was the second highest in the country and seven times more than the average across Britain.

This is after spending £650,000 of

rate payer's money on a new entrance to the Town Hall in Walthamstow and over £18,700 on new tables for the committee rooms.

#### What does the Council have to hide?

A scrutiny panel, set up to investigate what happened to the £8 or £9 million that was allocated to put unemployed people in Waltham Forest into a job, has been closed down by the Labour Party.

When Tesco was built in Highams Park the company agreed to give £1.1 million for health provision in the borough.

This is a legal agreement as part of the planning approval.

So far £920,000 has been spent on the **Thorpe Hall School** development and the extension to the **Handsworth Health Centre**.

At the time of going to press your **Focus Team** has not been able to find out where the remaining £179,000 will be spent.
